More inconvenient truths about Al Sadowski:

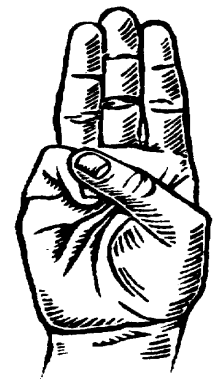
- *Appointed by the party bosses*, Al voted with them 217 times – never against them¹
